Bellingham, WA – Mt. Baker Foothills area resident Linda Dorsett was tragically killed in an accident on Friday, June 17. Linda was dedicated to the Foothills community, volunteering much of her time and talents to numerous efforts.

“Linda loved this community and devoted herself to making it an even more vital place,” said Carole MacDonald, Mt. Baker Foothills Chamber of Commerce president and owner of the Inn at Mount Baker. “East Whatcom Regional Resource Center was a particular passion of hers. She wanted to see it open and serving Foothills residents.”

The Linda Dorsett Memorial Fund has been established at the Whatcom Community Foundation to celebrate Linda’s life. “The Fund will benefit the East Whatcom Regional Resource Center,” added MacDonald. “Linda worked hard to bring it to fruition. It meant a lot to her.” The Center was built by Whatcom County and will be operated by the Opportunity Council. It is scheduled to open in September. Funds will be used to purchase materials and other resources for the Center.
