Sculptor Bob McDermott, creator of "Dirty Dan Harris" in Fairhaven and "Vigil" in Blaine, has been commissioned to create a magnificent commemorative bronze statue of Holden and Phoebe Goodell Judson, the founders of Lynden. This beautiful, life-sized statue will be placed on the grounds of Lynden's new City Hall.

The statue will be based upon a well-known photograph of the Judsons, taken on their 50th Wedding Anniversary in 1899. Phoebe is affectionately known as "The Mother of Lynden" and Holden was Lynden's first Mayor. The citizens of Lynden, along with family members, historians and admirers of the Judsons, are invited to join in paying tribute to these beloved pioneers.

Categories

"Bricks" are standard sized, red construction bricks, approx 4" X 8" surface area.

"Pavers" are stone slabs, which are more durable and attractive than brick and may be sized according to price. Inscription size and design are more flexible than for bricks.

"Bronzes" are plaques cast in bronze and inscribed with the wording and logo of your choice, depending upon amount of donation. They are permanent and weatherproof.
